Obituaries

WALTER "RAY" BELL, JR., Walter or "Ray" peacefully passed away May 23, 2011. Bom in Port Chester, NY on October 30, 1920, Ray moved with his family to Armonk in 1929. Ray enlisted in the Naval Reserves and was stationed in both the Philadelphia and Brooklyn Naval Yards. Three months after the bombing of Pearl Harbor, he proudly joined the U.S. Marines on March 26, 1941 and served with B-1-2 from 9/42 to 7/44 where he participated in the Guadalcanal, Tarawa, Sal pan and Tinian campaigns. As a machine gunner, he was wounded on Tarawa on 11/22/43 and again on Saipan on 7/8/44, which awarded him two purple hearts. Ray was very proud of being a Marine and many would say that the Marines were his life. In the 50's he began a 30 year vocation in the Readers Digest, where he retired in 1982. Ray had four loves - his faith, his country, his family and his many friends. Upon his retirement from the Readers Digest, he found he had a talent for writing poetry (where he began to use the name Walter) and wrote over 50 poems reflecting his love of country, his battles in WWII, his love of nature and animals and his love of God. Ray was a Life Member of North Castle American Legion Post #1097 and Marine Corps League plus numerous Marine Corps Associations
