Life Member William A. Young William Arthur Young, Jr.,91, died on March 5,2012. Bill Young was born on May 25,1920, In Manhattan to William and Margaret Young. Bill graduated from Fordham Prep and St. John's University, where he played baseball for legendary coach Joe Lapchick. Bill then enlisted in the United States Marine Corps and was commissioned as a 2nd Lieutenant. He served in the Pacific in W.W.II with the 1st Marine Division and was awarded a Purple Heart and two Bronze Stars (with V for valor) for his service on New Britain, Peleliu and Okinawa. After the war, Bill went to work for the F.W. Woolworth Company and remained there until he retired in 1988. Bill married the former Eileen M. Hearn of Yonkers in 1942. Bill and Eileen were married for 64 years when she passed away in 2006. Residents of Tarrytown since 1962, Bill and Eileen had six children, five of them graduates of Sleepy Hollow High School. Over the years, Bill coached Dad's Club, Babe Ruth, and American Legion baseball in Tarrytown. A long-time member of the Knollwood Country Club and the Lyceum Club.
