Member Obituaries

Life Member Robert Philip Reisman, of Eastchester, died Tuesday, April 24, at Calvary Hospital in the Bronx. He was 89. A retired police officer and head of security at Chase Manhattan Bank, Reisman was a third-degree member of Knights of Columbus Rev. John A. Keogh Council in Tuckahoe. He also was a parishioner of Immaculate Conception Church in Tuckahoe since 2005. The eldest son of Edward and Rose Angela Lucchini Reisman, he was born June 17, 1922, in Mount Vernon. Reisman attended public elementary schools in Mount Vernon and the North Bronx and Evander Childs High School in the Bronx. He enlisted in the Marine Corps on March 21, 1941, and was discharged six months later to assist his family during the Great Depression. Reisman re-enlisted on Oct. 10, 1942, and was followed into the service by his two younger brothers. The trio served in the Pacific Theatre together. He participated in

the Battle of Tinian in 1944 and a year later he witnessed the takeoff of the Enola Gay as it began its atomic bomb mission over Japan. He was discharged on Dec. 10, 1945, with the rank of corporal. Reisman joined the Mount Vernon Police Department in 1946 as part of a class of 24 returning war veterans. He served in the detective division from 1952 to 1963 and was appointed commanding officer of the detective division and the records division in 1968. He retired with the rank of lieutenant on June 10, 1971. He later worked for many years as chief of security for Chase Manhattan Bank in lower Manhattan. He was a former member and past president of the Mount Vernon Police Holy Name Society, a former usher at Sts. Peter and Paul Church in Mount Vernon and a member of the Westchester County detachment of the Marine Corps League.

Life Member Arnold G. Edson of New Rochelle died May 1. He was 95. A retired U.S. Marine Major, he served during World War II at Guadalcanal, Saipan and Okinawa. Edson attended New York University and graduated with a Bachelor of Science from the University of Southern California. He worked in the toy manufacturing industry, first for Ideal Toy Company, then for AMSCO. Edson eventually set up a toy manufacturing factory in Hong Kong, which he sold in 1985. He was active in the Old Guard of White Plains and served as a past board member of the Wine and Food Society of New York. Edson was a life member of the Westchester County Marine Corps League and past member of Temple Israel in New Rochelle. Edson also served as board member of the Scarsdale Adult School, Temple M'Vakshe Derekh in Scarsdale and the American

Institute of Archeology in Scarsdale.

Life Member Frederick Johannsen

of Verplanck,NY, died on Monday,
April 30,2012. He was the owner of the
Viking Boat Yard in Verplanck, NY. Mr.
Johannsen graduated from Peekskill
high school in 1955 and served in the
United States Marine Corps from
1957-1961. He was the son of Emil
and Agnes Johannsen of Peekskill,
NY. He will be remembered as a great
husband, father, brother, grandfather
and most of all a hard worker who was
always willing to work more than a day
for a day's pay.
