WASHINGTON — A Marine three-star general will take control of the Defense Intelligence Agency later this month, marking the first time a Marine has held that post, the Pentagon said Tuesday.

Maj. Gen. Vincent Stewart will be promoted to lieutenant general and take over the DIA on Jan. 23. His promotion was confirmed last month by the U.S. Senate.

Most recently Stewart was serving as the head of Marine Forces Cyber Command, and he has also been the Corps' intelligence director.
